Eagle Scout Board of Review Requirements

1. The District Advancement Chair (or other appointed District Committee member) is required to attend all Eagle Scout Board of Reviews.
2. There shall be no fewer than three and no more than six members, all at least 21 years old.
3. They need not be registered adult leaders, but should have an understanding of the rank and purpose and importance of the review.
4. The board of review members cannot be currently registered as Scoutmasters or Assistant Scoutmasters in the Troop.
5. The Eagle Scout candidate contacts the Advancement Chair, Committee Chair, Scoutmaster, etc. and they will select the two (five maximum) board of review members.
6. The Eagle Scout candidate does not select the board of review members.
7. The Eagle Scout candidate coordinates the date, time, and location of the board of review with the District Advancement Chair. Typical locations are rooms in schools, churches, homes, etc. If a public place is chosen, it needs to be suitable for a meeting.
8. The Eagle Scout candidate is expected to wear his complete uniform with merit badge sash.
