**NYLT** is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide Boy Scouts, Venturers, Sea Scouts, and Explorers with leadership skills and experiences they can use in their home troops, crews, ships, posts, personal lives, and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others.

## What to Expect at NYLT

**NYLT** is a challenging and rewarding six-day learning experience. Leadership skills are taught in a Troop setting as a framework to make the learning fun and allow immediate application of the leadership principles.

Participants from different units are grouped into small groups called patrols, to make new friends, exchange ideas, and travel through the stages of team building together. Teamwork is reinforced by cooking meals, actively competing through games, and working together as patrols throughout the experience.

As a participant, it is an honor to be selected by your troop, crew, ship or post to represent them and to interact with other top leaders on course. Our participants remark from year to year how glad they were that they attended, how much they learned, the fun they had, and that they would highly recommend the course to others.

National standards **require attendance for all 6 days of the course.**



## Fees and Deposits

**Fee:** \$265 (min. \$100 deposit required)

**Final payment is due by May 31, 2018.**

**Discount:** \$15 for those who also attend 2017 summer camp at Parsons or Pigott.

## Refunds

Deposits are not refundable. In the event of accident, illness, or extreme extenuating circumstances, refunds of up to 50% of camp fees may be made if requested in writing at least 15 days prior to your scheduled arrival at camp.

**Refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Camping Department.**

## What to Bring to Camp

After your registration is accepted, you will receive a welcome email with a list of what to bring to NYLT. In general, a participant will bring camping gear for five nights and six days. Food and cookware for meals is provided. Be sure to indicate shirt size on the application form to insure proper fit of the provided course tee shirt.

## Who May Attend

Boy Scouts who are at least first class and will be 13 by the start of the course as well as all male Venturers, Sea Scouts and Explorers may attend any of the sessions.

Due to the difference in staffing requirements, only Session 4, 8/13 - 8/18, will be co-ed to accommodate female Venturers, Sea Scouts, and Explorers.
