### More About Camp

The program includes fun activities throughout the camp such as snow sports (weather-permitting), scavenger hunts, games, crafts, day hikes, campfires and outdoor cooking. Snowy conditions are not guaranteed but there will still be plenty to do. Cub Scout

advancements will also be offered. Camp Sheppard's nine heated cabins each sleep 24 people in bunks with mattresses. Restrooms are centrally located and the lodge provides a warm haven. For your convenience the trading post

will be open with snacks, craft items, t-shirts and more.
