More About Camp

This is a 24-hr camp, with arrival at 9:00 am Saturday and departure by 10:00 am Sunday. When you arrive, you will check in at the camp office, then be guided to your campsite to meet your fellow camp mates. Camp Pigott's campsites feature

tents on platforms that sleep two, and cabins that sleep eight. The new shower building, featuring individual shower rooms and flush toilets, is located nearby.

Throughout the day, there is archery, BB gun shoot-

ing, crafts, games, Scoutcraft, skit training, nature activity and outdoor learning. Between rotations, meals are served in the dining hall.

How to Register

The fee is **\$57 per person**. More than one Scout may attend with their mom, dad or other adult relative. Dens and packs are encouraged to sign up together but a separate registration is **required** for each family. Packs are grouped in the same campsite.
