Charles Sommer Wilderness Canoe Base – take treks into Boundary Waters Canoe Area

Wilderness and north into Quetico Provincial Park in Ontario

Don Rogert Canoe Base - explore the pristine, well-preserved wilderness of the Quetico Provincial Parks; lounge on the sandy beaches and swim in the turquoise waters of Canadian Crownlands, an area often referred to as “the Carribean of the North”; and visit the White Otter Castle, a five-story wilderness mansion built by one man in 1914, and stumble across long-abandoned gold mines in the Turtle River – White Otter Provincial Park.

Northern Expeditions Canoe Base - Bissett, Manitoba

Unofficially regarded as the “Most Extreme High Adventure in Scouting,” the Northern Expeditions base is the most rugged and remote region paddled by Northern Tier. A float plane drops crews off at our wilderness canoe cache in the heart of the combined two million acre Atikaki Provincial Park and Woodland Caribou Provincial Park, an area visited by only a handful of canoeists every year.
