WHY (RAFTS?

Why do we use Crafts in Cubs?

- ★Kids get bored when you talk to them
- **★**Completes a requirement
- ★Reinforces concepts learned in the adventures
- ★Kids learn to make useful things
- **★**Gets parents involved
- ★Parents get a tangible item to keep



WHY (RAFTS?

What can Crafts Teach Cubs?

- **★**New skills
- ★Fine Motor Muscles & Hand-Eye Coordination
- ★ How to try different ways of doing things
- ★ How to create something with their hands
- **★**Determination and persistence
- ★Pride in their hard work



DO'S AND DON'TS

DON'T

- Use a craft just to fill time
- Craft at every den meeting
- Make complicated crafts that are frustrating to complete
- them give up!

DO

- Crafting with a purpose (service projects, gifts, advancement)
- Vary the types of crafts
- Send unfinished crafts home to complete with family
- Find crafts that are ageappropriate and challenging

HOW TO INTRODUCE A CRAFT

- 1) Test the craft yourself. If you have a spare Scout sitting around, have them test it too.
- 2) Make a finished sample and any patterns you might need.
- 3) For wood projects, it is helpful to have most of the cutting done ahead of time.
- 4) Try to have enough tools for everyone. Have parents bring their own if they can.

HOW TO INTRODUCE A CRAFT

- 4) Make sure you have enough materials for everyone to get started at the same time.
- 5) Teach the craft step by step. You may have to go over the steps several times.
- 6) Enlist parents to help! Send unfinished crafts home for finishing.
- 7) If possible, display the finished crafts at your next den or pack meeting.






