Commission Checks



Groups will only have to pay Chief Seattle Council if they have a negative (net sales balance). We suggest groups process sales through the Trail's End app/website to keep their balance up to date.

- Online Direct sales are automatically process in the app/website.
- Credit/debit card sales are automatically process in the app/website.
- Checks & cash deposited into group's bank account.
 - No need for deposit slips.

The deadline to pay off a negative balance **December 16**.

Store Front Sales



Groups have the option of starting their store-front sales anytime between August 14 & October 31.

King County districts will be managed through the Trail's End app/website. All sites managed last year have been approached, plus additional sites.

Leaders will select, view, and claim site sales through the Trail's End Unit Leader portal. Between **July 15** and **21** groups will reserve sites. The sites will be allocated in rounds (each day), by district, and previous year sale totals.

Kitsap is managed through district popcorn volunteers. Groups will select, view, and claim site sales the same way as previous years.

Grand Columbia & Mt. Olympus managed their own site sales.

Groups can approach stores and businesses not coordinated by the district or council.

Wagon Sales (With Product)



Scouts have product on hand and go door-to-door to ask for support. This is a great method for neighborhoods with homes close together.

Customers will receive their popcorn orders quicker and the sale is simpler than a take order.

Product needs to be on hand with the Scout when asking customers.

Any leftover product can be used to fill take orders or transferred to other groups.

10% of a group's cases can be returned, no chocolate.

Wagon Sales (Take Order)



Scouts collect orders in the Trail's End app and mark product as "undelivered" to be delivered later. Scouts can go through their neighborhood, parent's place of work, and ask friends/family members.

It's up to the Scout to decide when payment is collected. We suggest Scouts collect payment when the Take Order is asked.

Popcorn can be picked up at any of the popcorn delivery dates.

Scouts can use a take order form for record keeping but all orders need to be recorded in the app/website.

A direct link to your fundraising page is also included in the communication. Customers have the option to stop receiving these messages at any time.

When prompted, be sure to allow the app access to your device's contacts. This is required in order to use the Autoshare feature.

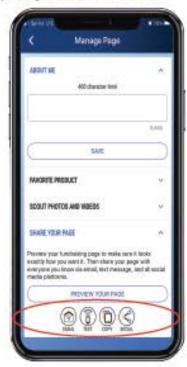

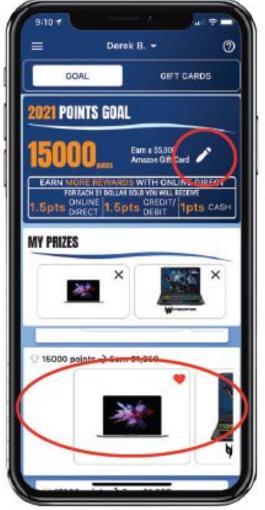

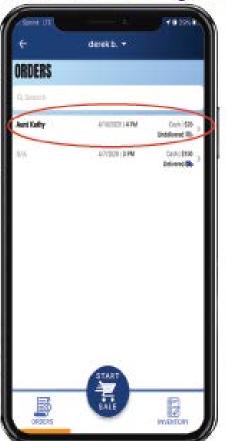
