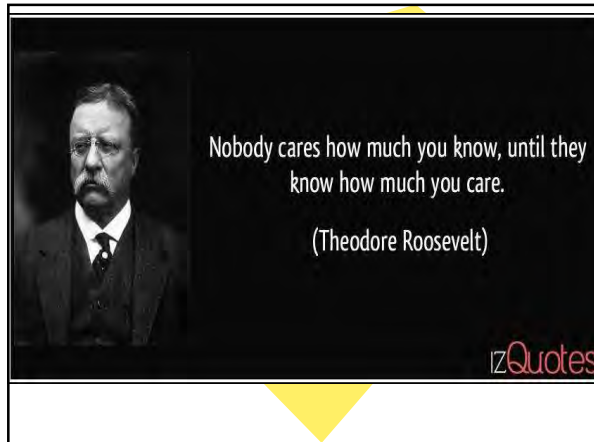
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A Little Fellow Follows Me by Lee Fisher

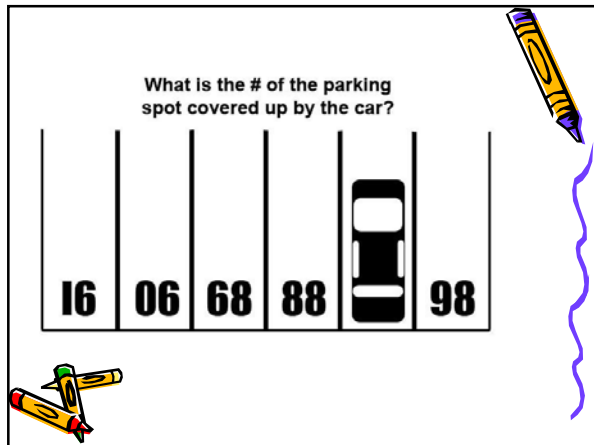
A careful leader I want to be. A little fellow follows me;

 I am building for the years to be, that little chap who follows me.



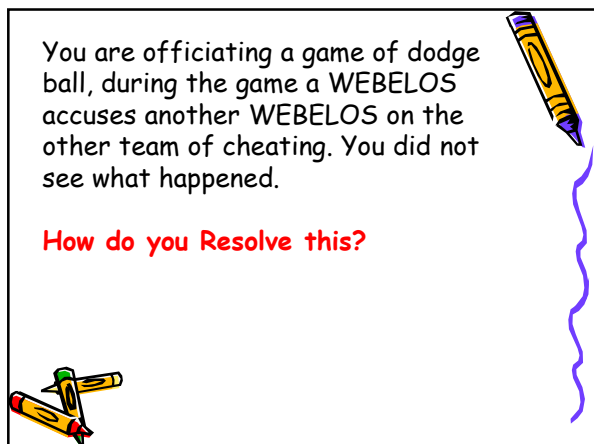
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
