Pillar of Puget Sound Recipients Terry Gillespie and John Stanton

Terry Gillespie served 15 years at Western Wireless
Corporation as Chief Financial Officer. Prior to that, Terry
was Controller of McCaw Cellular. Terry received her BA in
Accounting from the University of Washington. She serves
on the Board of Trustees of Fred Hutchinson Cancer
Research Center. She is also a co-founder and director of
Trilogy International Partners. She is also a member of the
Washington State Opportunity Scholarship Board of
Directors.

John Stanton is a pioneer of the wireless industry. During the 1980s, John served as Chief Operating Officer of McCaw Cellular, which became the largest wireless operator in the US. Later, along with Theresa, they formed Western Wireless Corporation, which John led as Chairman and Chief Executive Officer. He also served as chairman and CEO of VoiceStream Wireless, which eventually was renamed T-Mobile USA.

John is Chairman of Trilogy International Partners and co-founder of Trilogy Search Partners. John also serves on the board of directors of Microsoft Corporation and Costco Wholesale and previously served on the board of Columbia Sportswear Co. In addition, John serves as Chairman and Managing Partner of the partnership that owns the Seattle Mariners.

John and Terry are committed to improving the lives of children and families in our region. In the last decade, John has chaired or co-chaired the Business Partnership for Early Learning, the United Way of King County campaign, Whitman College, the Washington Roundtable and the Regional Transportation Commission. He currently serves as the Chairman of Year Up of Puget Sound and a board member at the Institute for Health Metrics Evaluation. John received his BA in political science from Whitman College and an MBA from Harvard Business School. John and Terry have two sons.







Scouts!






Chief Seattle Council Serves over 9,000 youth in King, Kitsap, Clallam, Jefferson, and North Mason Counties
