Scoutreach is Chief Seattle Council's program serving at-risk youth in King County. The program's mission is to give every boy and girl the opportunity to benefit from Chief Seattle Council programs, regardless of their background or personal circumstances. To deliver this program, Chief Seattle Council partners with local agencies, bringing the program directly to where youth spend their time.

The Scoutreach program is inspired by traditional Boy Scout programming, with consideration given to the challenges at-risk youth face. Youth in this program receive lessons in character development, skill-building, teamwork, and service to others.

Over 1,000 youth were served in 2023 in the Scoutreach program!

*We are so grateful for our partnership with Scoutreach! Some highlights - The kids are learning material and receiving content we wouldn't typically be able to provide....*

*Kids have learned financial literacy, talking through the value of saving v spending, and been able to "buy" prizes with their earnings. We're currently loving the safety unit - it gives us so much to go back and discuss - safe responses, safe adults, how to help, distinguishing "big" emergencies from things we can solve on our own.*

*Many of our kids come from low-income households - the statistics at Bailey state that about 90% of students rely on free/reduced lunches.*
