#2 Scouts Lead: Chaos Tolerated

- If I had a nickel for every time a parent said....
- Youth-run and adult mentored
- Voice from the back
- Provide a safe environment for the youth to fail
- Make failures a learning experience by asking leading questions
- ALWAYS jump in when safety is being compromised!





#3 Camping Happens

- ¾ of Scouting is OUTING
- The outdoor classroom is where real learning, confidence-building and independence is nurtured
- Statistics tend to bear this out!
 - Overnight outings
 - Camping
 - Summer camp
 - 50-milers and other high adventure trips









#4 Advancement is Tracked

- Advancement is the core of the Scouting Program!
- Advancement numbers are a good indicator of how good a program your unit has.
- A way to promote and encourage ongoing involvement.

Step 1: The Scout learns...

Step 2: The Scout is tested...

Step 3: The Scout is reviewed...

Step 4: The Scout is recognized





#5 Parents Are Involved

- Amazing opportunity to engage with your kids in a different way
- Lead by example
- Your enthusiasm (or lack thereof) is contagious
- More hands make for light work
- BSA does not stand for...(let's all say it together)



#7 Scout/Leaders Are Trained

- Unit has an "Introduction to Leadership Skills". BE, KNOW, DO.
- Scoutmasters are trained for their position
- Send your youth to NYLT
- Send your adults to Wood Badge
- Assign scoutmasters to each patrol
- New Scout patrol mentored by Troop Guides
- Learning never stops!





#8 Leadership Succession For Youth & Adult Planned

- Don't wait!
- Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader
- Troop Guides
- Scoutmaster, Assistant Scoutmaster
- Do you have enough ASMs?
- How old are their youth in your unit?
- Committee Chair, Chartered Org Rep, other key positions
- Outgoing Senior Patrol Leaders as JASMs
