

GRAND COLUMBIA TRAINING WEEKEND COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

BALOO

The BALOO course is a REQUIRED adult training allowing you to take your Pack or Webelos den camping, and everyone wants to do that!

BALOO has REQUIRED Prerequisite online learning modules (total of 35-40 mins), providing a knowledge base prior to taking the BALOO Outdoor course, which MUST be completed prior to attending the outdoor portion.

The second part of the training is a super fun, in-person camp out. You'll learn how to plan campouts Cub Style – with campfires, knives & knots, cooking & compass/GPS, gear, where to go, all the safety and rules you need to know before you go, and more.

IOLS

Working as patrols, this hands-on course provides adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Upon completion, leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First Class rank. Along with Scoutmaster Specifics this course is required of all direct contact leaders registered in Scouts BSA Troops in order to be considered “trained”.

Archery Level 1 Training

This is a private course, being offered to BSA Members, who are seeking Archery L1 Instructor training to serve others by staffing Archery Ranges. The USA Archery L1 Instructor will learn about Range Safety, Range Set-up, the Steps-to-Shooting, Archery Equipment, Repair and Maintenance, Programs and Lesson Plans; in addition to acquiring and demonstrating the SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE & ATTITUDE necessary to Safely Run an Archery Range.

The USA Archery Level 1 (L1) Instructor Certification course provides graduates the necessary tools to maintain a high level of SAFETY, both on and off the archery ranges for camps archery programs. To successfully complete the requirements for this certification, students **MUST FIRST** successfully pass the USA Archery L1 Instructor Certification ONLINE COURSE, including the online exam (**STEP ONE** - through USA Archery).

Archery Level 2 Training

This is a private course, being offered to BSA Members, who are seeking Archery L2 Instructor training. Those desiring to obtain L2 Instructor Status should start the process ASAP, as the Background Check is Required before you can start the ONLINE Course. Note that this Background Check is through USA Archery and the BSA is not involved and has NO CONTROL over this process.

Candidates must then COMPLETE SafeSports Training which is similar to Youth Protection Training.

Level 1 Instructor rating is NOT REQUIRED / Pre-requisite for taking Level 2 Instructor Training.

Operation of BB, archery, and slingshot ranges for activities and events, including day camp, long-term camp, and short-term camping programs require qualified, trained Rangemasters.

BB/slingshot rangemaster certifications are valid for two years from the date of the training.
