

They may earn these awards until their 19th birthday. Any Venturer or Sea Scots who achieved the First Class rank in a Scots and a Lore Scots may confirm werking for the Star, Life, and Eagle Scots in the Eagle Palms white might send as a Menturer or Sea Scots up to their 18th birthday. - Earn early, especially required merit badges with time requirements

- Serve in a position of responsibility
- Six months
- While a Life Scout





#### Guidepost 5: Perform Significant Service Project

- While a Life Scout
- Plan, develop and give leadership to religious institution, school or community
- Approvals required
- Use Eagle Service Project Workbook

- While Life Scout

- Before your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday

- Statement of ambitions and life purpose

- Attach to your Eagle Scout rank application
