Chief Seattle Council Venturing Pistol Program Participation and Hold Harmless Agreement

Chief Seattle Council offers Venturing Scouts the opportunity to participate in pistol safety and marksmanship programs. This program is conducted under the approval of the Boy Scouts of America. Scouts will be instructed how to handle, maintain, and shoot a pistol safely and be provided instruction to increase their marksmanship skills. Scouts will have both classroom instruction and range instruction in which they will fire a pistol under the supervision of a trained Range Safety Officer and pistol instructor. Scouts will be required to wear eye protection and ear protection at all times while on the range. Scouts are expected to abide by all safety rules and the instructions of the Range Safety Officer(s) and Pistol Instructor(s).

I, the undersigned, give my child, ________, permission to participate in this program. I understand that participation in any activity involves a certain degree of risk. I have carefully considered the risk involved and have given consent for my child to participate in the activity. I understand that participation in the activity is entirely voluntary and requires participants to abide by the rules and standards of conduct. I release the Boy Scouts of America, the local council, the activity coordinators and all employees, volunteers, related parties or other organizations associated with the activity from any and all claims or liability arising out of this participation.

For safety, my child and I agree that he/she will do the following or he/she will be removed from the program. Because this is a pilot program and space is limited, any additional cost associated with participation in this program will not be refunded.

- 1. Complete the First Steps Class or 30 range minute orientation taught at Camp.
- 2. Wear all safety gear at all times while on the range.
- 3. Follow all the safety rules provided in the training class.
- 4. Follow the instructions of the Range Safety Officer(s) and Pistol Instructor(s).
- 5. Do not handle the pistols until instructed to do so by the Pistol Instructor(s).
- 6. Follow the instructions of the Range Safety Officer(s) at all times.
- 7. Is 14 years of age, or 13 and has completed the 8th grade, as of the start of the class and will be in full compliance with all local state and federal guidelines, including age restrictions and original equipment manufacturer standards.
- 8. Is a registered in a Venture Crew or is interested in joining one and has completed the application.
- 9. I am not prohibited by Federal, State or local law from possessing a handgun or ammunition.
